Christian Education Meeting:

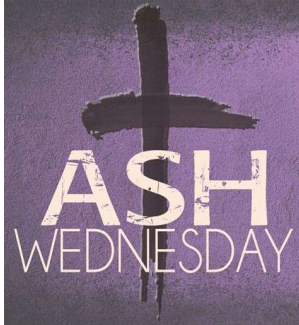
Christian Education Committee will meet following worship On February 1st to make plans for the coming year. Please meet in the lounge.
