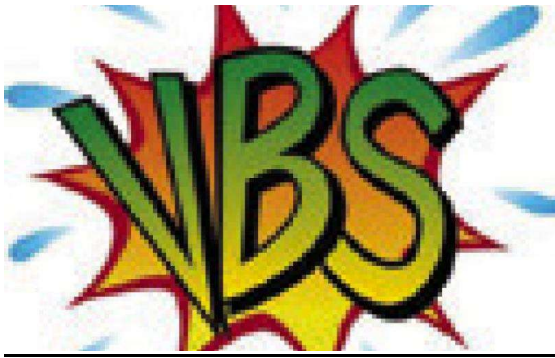


## Nelsons Chicken & Ribs:
